Dubai, U.A.E.:



I look forward to welcoming all AiO Logistics Network members to Dubai!

One of the reasons this place is so popular with freight forwarders is that Dubai is not only well placed in the Persian Gulf for trade, but it is a commercial and cultural crossroads for Asia, Africa and Europe. You will find a new city when you arrive, but keep in mind that Dubai has come a long way on its journey to being a major world city. It was settled in the 1700s as an insignificant fishing village but the city proliferated in the early 21st century with a focus on logistics, distribution, tourism, and luxury, having the second most five-star hotels in the world, after London. Dubai also

boasts the tallest building in the world, the towering Burj Khalifa, which stands at 828 meters (2,717 ft) tall. I hope those of us who haven't yet seen the Burj will get to on this trip. Dubai as well is currently by far the most populous city in the United Arab Emirates (UAE) and the capital city of the Emirate of Dubai. Last year Dubai had a population of around 3.49 million, and it is still growing.

Dubai is specifically of interest to international logistics professionals like us. Being situated in the eastern Arabian Peninsula on the coastline of the Persian Gulf, it goes without saying that Dubai is also a major international transport hub for cargo. Originally it was oil revenue that helped accelerate the city's economic development, which was already a crucial and important regional business center. A hub for regional and international trade since the early 20th century, Dubai's economy now greatly relies on revenues from many developed industries involved in trade, tourism, aviation, real estate, and financial services. Though oil production contributed less than 1 percent of the emirate's GDP in 2018 yet it is still a driver for much of the logistics services for the region. During the past few decades, Dubai developed two major international airports as air cargo hubs: Dubai International Airport (DXB) and Al Maktoum International Airport (DWB). Dubai has also developed two major commercial ports in Dubai, Port Rashid and Port Jebel Ali. Port Jebel Ali, in a free trade zone, is the world's largest man-made harbor, the biggest port in the Middle East, and the 7th-busiest port in the world.

In addition to all that, Dubai offers copious shopping opportunities whether it be fashion, electronics, souvenirs, or almost anything else you can imagine. And Dubai has some of the best cuisines in the world. Also, you won't have a lack of things to do since Dubai offers numerous forms of entertainment, from desert safaris, to horse racing, to skiing, to live bands in the evening.

But I will give you the best reason to be with us in Dubai: To meet new friends and deepen relationships within the network. There will be people from all over the world there to see you and develop business with you. This is the real benefit to you and your company so make sure to be there!

DUBAI, U.A.E.

With year-round sunshine, intriguing deserts, beautiful beaches, luxurious hotels and shopping malls, fascinating heritage attractions and a thriving business community, Dubai receives millions of leisure and business visitors each year from around the world. These visitors can benefit from a range of services and a local infrastructure that help make any trip to Dubai smooth and hassle-free.

Dubai has a warm, sunny climate that is ideal for tourism, with mild temperatures for most of the year and a low rainfall. Summer temperatures in July and August can reach highs of around 45°C (113°F) with high humidity, making this the least comfortable time of year to visit in terms of climate. However, Dubai is well geared up for high temperatures, and public transport, shopping malls, hotels, restaurants and visitor attractions are all air conditioned.

English is widely spoken in Dubai, and as all restaurant menus, road signs and other information is usually presented in both English and Arabic, visitors who speak English will have no trouble making their way around. Many tour operators and travel professionals will also be able to offer services to French, Russian and German speaking visitors.









The local currency is the dirham, which is pegged to the dollar at Dhs 3.67. Dubai offers a sophisticated network of banks, currency exchanges and ATMs, making it easy to access money across the city.

Dubai is tolerant and cosmopolitan and all visitors are welcome. However, Islam is a way of life in the city, and therefore tourists should adopt a certain level of cultural and religious sensitivity for the duration of their stay. While dress codes are fairly liberal, swim wear should only be worn on beaches or at swimming pools, and when visiting shopping malls and other attractions, tourists should wear clothing that is not too tight or revealing. Certain attractions, such as mosques or religious sites, usually have stricter dress codes, requiring both men and women to cover up bare shoulders, arms and legs, and women to wear headscarves.

Despite being governed by Islamic laws, alcohol is available to tourists in licensed bars and restaurants (these are almost always located inside four and five star hotels), and in airport duty free shops.
