

Visa Guidelines to Cambodia

If hold a nationality in an ASEAN country - Brunei, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, the Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, or Vietnam, you do not require a visa for entry into Cambodia. The duration of your stay can range from 14 to 30 days, depending on your country of origin.

For individuals of other nationalities, the option is available to apply for a Cambodian e-visa through online channels. The eVisa remains valid for three months from the date of issuance and permits a single entry into Cambodia for tourism purposes. Visitors under this visa can stay for a maximum of 30 days from their date of arrival. Consequently, entry into Cambodia must occur no later than the final day of the eVisa's validity, allowing for a maximum 30-day stay as a tourist visitor. Obtaining an electronic visa is a straightforward process that involves completing an online form. The processing time is **three business days**. Upon approval, your eVisa will be automatically sent to the email address provided in your application form. Alongside your passport, it is mandatory to carry a printed copy of the eVisa to the airport, where customs officials will verify the details.
